

WHAT IS HOME HEALTH CARE? IS IT RIGHT FOR MY FAMILY?

Home health is designed for patients who have increased fatigue and/or difficulty leaving the home and who do so infrequently and in short durations. It allows the patient to be more independent in their home and can be provided for patients in their own home, Independent Living Facilities or Assisted Living Facilities. Services are typically 100% covered for patients with traditional Medicare part A benefits.

People who may benefit from home health include those with:

- balance problems or falls
- decreased mobility
- uncontrolled diabetes
- uncontrolled high blood pressure
- complications after stroke or other neurological diagnoses
- new medications or diagnoses
- frequent hospitalizations
- respiratory problems
- · changes in mental status
- chronic pain
- wound care needs

Classic Home Health provides physical therapy, occupational therapy, or speech therapy in the home setting instead of in a clinic. Services may also include nursing visits to the home on an intermittent basis to be the "eyes" of the physician and provide any medical management that may be needed. Patients who are receiving the aforementioned services may also qualify for a home health aid to provide personal care such as bathing and dressing assistance, if needed.

"Almost all patients would benefit from skilled home health services," said Stacy. "We would love the opportunity to show you how well we can care for your loved one. They truly desire to remain in their home safely and we are able to assist them in meeting that goal with confidence."
